Dear John & Janice,

as I write this we still miss two volunteers for the webmaster and Centre Sec roles. I thought it might help to give a bit more information on what the roles involve.

The website we have is supported & hosted by Webador & paid for by MSCC. The Webmaster needs then to populate the site with updated events etc. This isn't difficult. If you can make a power point presentation you can do that. Please let me know if you are interested.

The Centre Sec role as I do it now is really in 3 parts which could be split:-

1. National Committee Membership and a conduit to information from the centre such as new members, events etc. This may change and Jann will explain her plans which the NCM support to reduce this role to being a contact email for the centre.
2. Membership secretary for the centre. this involves maintaining the members register & then once a year checking the members still want to be in the centre and are members of MSCC. I also pass onto Simon Daunt the info you want in the members handbook. I also contact in area new MSCC members to tell them about us and offer membership to AngleMog.
3. A centre leadership role. Ideally the CS should join the Noggins & I don't as it is over 100 miles round trip to Chelmsford for me. I collate the Parish Notices, other announcements & the input to Miscellany. I also chair

committee meetings as needed. This year we had 2.

These roles could be split so if you are interested in all or part of CS role please let me know.
